



Toilet Training Policy

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Purpose

To ensure all children are supported in their toilet training journey whilst at the service. Staff will assist in the guidance of toilet training whenever possible.

Policy

Educators will assist in the guidance of toilet training whenever possible whilst ensuring their own health and safety and the supervision of all other children in their care.

Procedure

Sufficient clothes need to be provided by parents. If sufficient clothes are not provided spare clothes will be used. These clothes will need to be washed by the parents and returned.

Children who continually soil their clothes with bowel movements will be encouraged to try at a later date. This will be discussed with families by the Team Leader/Director.

Children who continually soil their clothes and also proceed to make a mess in the bathroom are seen to be not ready for toilet training. The health and safety of other children needs to be considered and the child will need to have sufficient pull-ups or nappies to continue attendance of the centre.

Educators are to remove the excess faeces from clothing but are NOT to wash out the clothes. The amount of time that staff spend washing out clothes means that all children are not receiving the supervision they should. It is also not in the best interest of the educators own health and safety.
